Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors (“Board”) of West Memorial Municipal Utility District will meet in regular session, open to the public, at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, November 25, 2024 at the West Memorial Municipal Utility District Sewage Treatment Plant, 22025 Kingsland Blvd., Katy, Texas, a designated meeting place inside the District. At such meeting the following matters will be discussed and acted upon, as appropriate:

 - a. Discussion related to STP members paying for anticipated repairs in advanced payment amounts;
8. Operator’s Report, including review and discuss operating expenses and consider authorizing action or repairs as recommended by the Operator;
 - a. Update on catwalk failure at plant;
9. Engineer’s Report, including:
 - a. Consider adoption of new water/sewer rates and amendment to Rate Order, as necessary;
 - b. Wastewater Treatment Plant repairs and improvements;
 - c. Status of construction projects and approval of pay estimates/change orders;
10. Attorney Report;
 - a. Update on mosquito spraying contract renewal;
 - b. Authorize filing of Annual Continuing Disclosure Report;
 - c. Adopt Order Designating Additional Meeting Place Outside Boundaries of District and authorize publication of notice;
 - d. Discussion related to park improvements;
11. Discuss pending business and matters for future agendas, including next meeting date;
12. *Executive Session pursuant to Texas Government Code, Section 551.071, et. seq.;
13. Reconvene in open session and authorize any action resulting from executive session;
14. Adjournment.
